- Improve all student outcomes in A-C data across all English, Science and Humanities.

## Our initiatives include

- Provide staff professional development and learning opportunities to improve understanding of the Positive Behaviour for Learning Framework and the requirements of the start-up phase.
- Implement the universal and Tier 1 systems and processes of the Positive Behaviour for Learning Framework.
- Collaboratively develop and implement the school behaviour management matrix and explicit behaviour lessons in alignment with the PBL Framework.
- Develop and implement Individual Learning Plans and Individual Behaviour Management Plans in collaboration with key stakeholders.
- Refine and maintain a whole school approach to the teaching of writing.
- Continue developing individual writing goals for all students based on the Australian Curriculum and Literacy Continuum.
- Celebrate the achievement of students in reaching their writing targets and behavioural expectations with classroom reward systems and end of term reward celebrations.

Increase Teacher Aide hours by 2 hours a week to support the implementation of the PBL Framework.	FTE: 0.12
Increase the Teacher Aide hours by 2 hours a week to support the writing goal setting and writing intervention processes.	TA Hours: 4.5 hours temporary a week
Providing staff with professional learning opportunities during staff meetings to build their capability to teach writing and understand the PBL Framework.	\$36.00 an hour
